



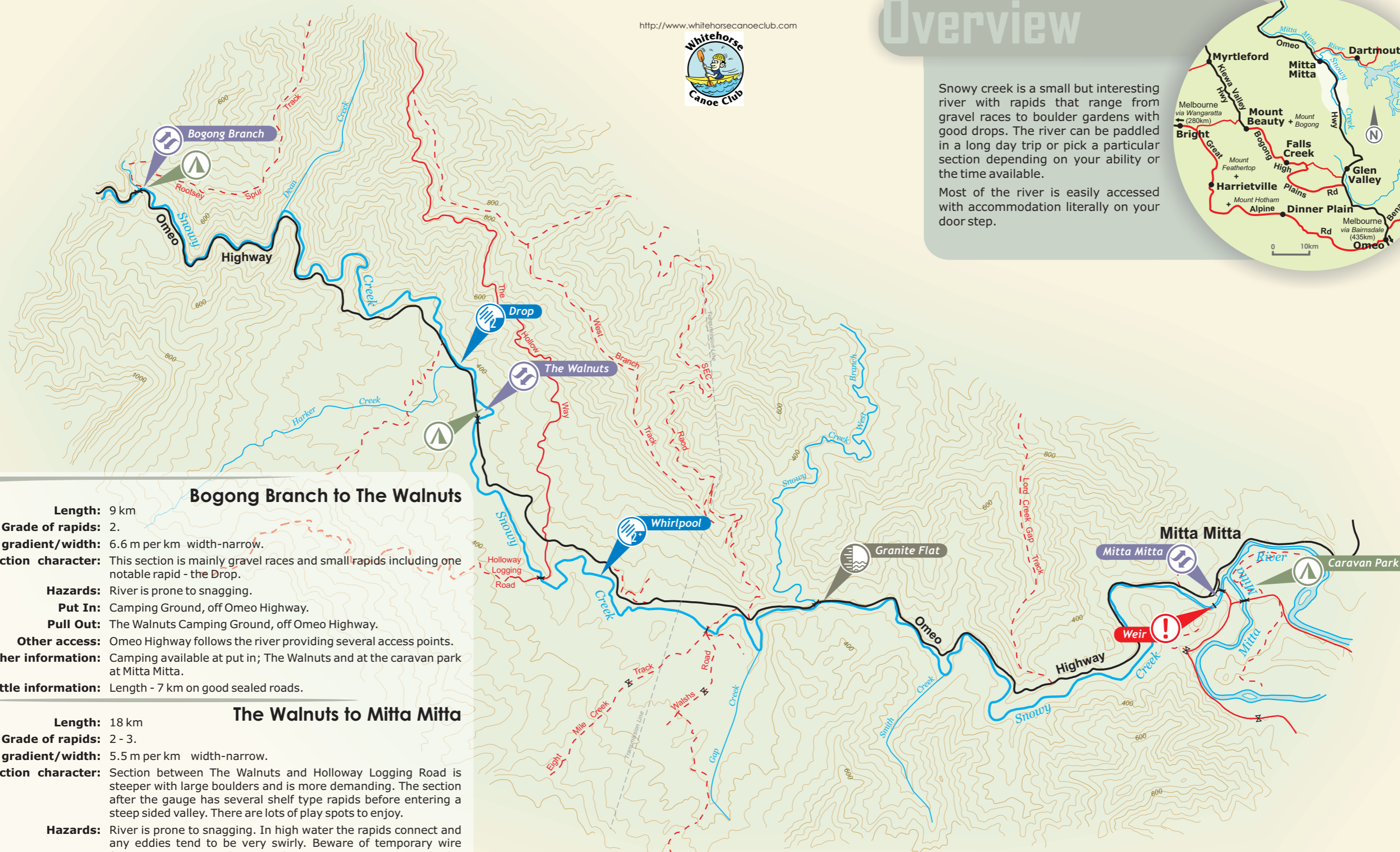
Overview

Snowy creek is a small but interesting river with rapids that range from gravel races to boulder gardens with good drops. The river can be paddled in a long day trip or pick a particular section depending on your ability or the time available.

Most of the river is easily accessed with accommodation literally on your door step.

Bogong Branch to The Walnuts

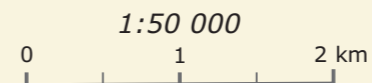
- Length:** 9 km
- Grade of rapids:** 2.
- River gradient/width:** 6.6 m per km width-narrow.
- Section character:** This section is mainly gravel races and small rapids including one notable rapid - the Drop.
- Hazards:** River is prone to snagging.
- Put In:** Camping Ground, off Omeo Highway.
- Pull Out:** The Walnuts Camping Ground, off Omeo Highway.
- Other access:** Omeo Highway follows the river providing several access points.
- Other information:** Camping available at put in; The Walnuts and at the caravan park at Mitta Mitta.
- Shuttle information:** Length - 7 km on good sealed roads.

The Walnuts to Mitta Mitta

- Length:** 18 km
- Grade of rapids:** 2 - 3.
- River gradient/width:** 5.5 m per km width-narrow.
- Section character:** Section between The Walnuts and Holloway Logging Road is steeper with large boulders and is more demanding. The section after the gauge has several shelf type rapids before entering a steep sided valley. There are lots of play spots to enjoy.
- Hazards:** River is prone to snagging. In high water the rapids connect and any eddies tend to be very swirly. Beware of temporary wire fences strung across the river. The weir at Mitta Mitta can also be dangerous particularly in short craft.
- Put In:** The Walnuts camping ground, river right, off Omeo Highway.
- Pull Out:** Mitta Mitta, reserve at the rear of the shop and hotel on river left.
- Other access:** Access from Holloway Logging Road and Walshs Road, also at various points from the Omeo Highway, particularly at the junction of the West Branch.
- Other information:** As per previous section. If camping at caravan park it is possible to paddle up the Mitta Mitta River to the caravan park.
- Shuttle information:** Length - 13 km on good sealed roads.
- River level:** Granite Flat - Min: 0.9 Good: 1.3 High: 1.9 Flood: 2.5
- Gauge:** Granite Flat, off Omeo Highway, 7 km south of Mitta Mitta, shortly after the confluence with the West Branch.
- Emergency contacts:** Nearest Police - Mitta Mitta, Wodonga (24 hours); nearest hospital - Wodonga; nearest town - Mitta Mitta.



True North and Magnetic North are shown for Mitta Mitta on this map. Magnetic Declination is 12°04' East, correct for 2005, and increases at a rate of approximately 01' every three years.
